

POLICY: Student fees for certain courses

ADOPTION DATE: 11-16-04

SEARCH: Fees

University Policy Executive memorandum 88-1 identifies the procedures establishing and approving fees assessed from students as they enroll in specific courses. All course fees assessed to students must be identified in advance and listed in the class schedule as well as the class syllabus.

Courses that utilize course fees are required to identify the amount of the course fee and explain the purpose of the course fee on the syllabus given to students.
