

POLICY: Grading System for Student Teaching
ADOPTIN DATE:

Student teaching uses a pass/fail grading system. Grades are based on supervisor's observations, feedback from cooperating teachers, written midterm & final evaluations from the cooperating teacher & the university supervisor, and the student's portfolio. Passing grades (85% or higher) on (1) at least the last two university supervisors observations, (2) a satisfactory or higher rating on all items of the final evaluation form completed by the cooperating teacher and the university supervisor AND (3) a check or check minus rating for each section of the portfolio must be obtained in order to pass student teaching. It is necessary for student teachers to pass student teaching in order to be endorsed for State of Utah licensure.

Students who do not meet all three criteria above are subject to faculty review (at risk of failing).
